CALL YOUR POISON CENTER

SAFE CLEANING & DISINFECTING

- Use products intended for indoor cleaning and disinfecting in your homes, work place, and schools.
- Follow directions for use on each cleaning product.
- **DO NOT** mix cleaning products together.
- Wear gloves and masks to protect skin and airway.

MEDICATION SAFETY

- Keep track of medications and order refills 1 week before your medication supply runs out or expires.
- **DO NOT** use prescription medications that are prescribed to others.
- Store medications safely. Unintentional medication exposures may result in hospitalization.

FOOD SAFETY

- Store perishable foods at the correct temperature.
- **DO NOT** consume foods and beverages past expiration dates listed on container.

PERSONAL HYGIENE

- Children and impaired persons should be supervised when using hand sanitizer to avoid ingestion and eye exposure.
- Clean skin and hair with products intended only for personal use.
