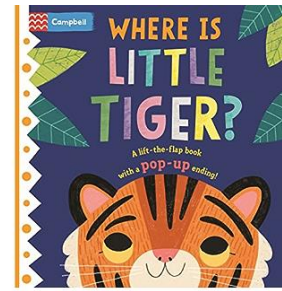
Object Permanence Activities

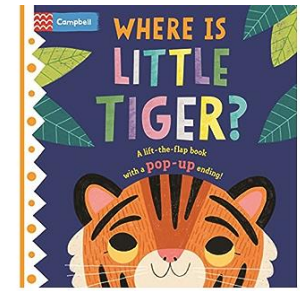
