


See, Touch, Feel Colors



Exploring colors with a trusted adult sets the groundwork for your baby to identify colors as a toddler.


There are 3 stages to learning colors.

- 1. Matching Colors:** Ask your toddler to match an object by color.
- 2. Pointing to Colors:** Ask your child to find a color they are familiar with.
- 3. Naming Colors:** Ask your toddler to identify an object by color.

*Color development will look different with every child.

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
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
